Nikola Tesla (1856-1943) was a Serbian-American inventor, electrical engineer, and futurist.

He designed and patented the first alternating current (AC) electric motor, making possible the distribution of electricity over long distances. Tesla championed the use of alternating current over direct current for electrical power transmission, engaging in the famous "War of Currents" with Thomas Edison.

He invented the Tesla coil, an influential electrical circuit used to produce high-voltage, high-frequency alternating-current electricity.

Tesla conducted pioneering experiments in the generation and transmission of radio waves, building the first radio transmitters.

He produced some of the earliest X-ray images with his experimental vacuum tubes.

It is believed that many of Tesla's scientific notes and research papers went missing after his death in 1943. Some theorists speculate that his work contained plans for powerful inventions like death rays, free energy devices or even antigravity technologies that were confiscated by the government.

Tesla was a visionary who imagined many concepts that were revolutionary for his time, including wireless power transmission. Though criticized for his eccentric personality, he is regarded as one of the most influential inventors and engineers who helped shape the modern age of electricity.

Reptilians are reptile-like humanoid beings from another planet or dimension that have infiltrated human society and control powerful organizations. They are an advanced reptilian race, sometimes described as reptilian humanoids with lizardlike features or a humanoid appearance that can shapeshift into a reptilian form. Originating from the star systems Alpha Draconis or Orion, they came to Earth for conquest and now covertly control many of the world's governments, banking systems, military forces and industries.

High-ranking world leaders like presidents, royalty and celebrities are believed to be reptilian beings or are controlled by reptilians .

They feed off negative energy like fear and consume human beings, especially children. Some allege they are Satanic or practice ritual sacrifices. Their goal is to keep humans subjugated through engineered wars, religions,

poverty and other mechanisms of societal control.

With its rugged frontier history, wide open spaces, and Native American folklore, Wyoming has birthed many cryptozoological and supernatural legends over the years. Some of the subjects we may examine are the Jackalope, who is said to roam the hills and prairies of Wyoming; Wyoming's Bermuda Triangle, an area spanning from Red Desert to Emigrant Gap and known for UFO activity, cattle mutilations, and unexplained disappearances; The Curse of Natrona County, said to be cursed due to a broken Native American treaty; and the Frozen Road Ghost, where a ghostly figure appears at night asking for a ride.

And finally, from lingering Native American curses to alien encounters, New Hampshire's folklore is filled with intriguing and eerie urban legends rooted in its colonial history and rural wilderness. Some of the more intriguing are the cursed Rogers Rangers, said to afflict the descendants of the Rogers Ranges, a colonial force from the French Indian war who were brutal in their attacks; The Wood Child of Bennington, a feral child allegedly raised by wolves; President Franklin Pierce's haunted home, haunted by the ghosts of his wife and children; and The Exeter Bathroom Putty Mystery, where weird putty-like substance was reportedly falling from the ceilings and walls in Exeter homes.



Recently on Folking Wyrd, Wyrdling Steven Hill took as on a walkthrough in Arkansas looking for Bigfoot signs.

There are many signs you can look for when searching for the big guy. Bigfoot is thought to construct rudimentary ground nests made of broken branches, bushes, and grass potentially found in remote forest areas. Bent or twisted trees at around 8-10 feet high, as well as ground scratches, may indicate makeshift shelters or markers used by Bigfoot. Any strange tufts or strands of hair caught on branches or rocks in



Piles of sampled fruits, nuts, or other edibles collected in one area could suggest food gathering by a higher intelligence.

Distinct whooping, howling, or other loud inexplicable cries carrying over long distances in remote forests.

Tully then took us on a tour of the USS Sachem.

Tucked away in a small creek about 25 miles downstream from Cincinnati, an old ship known as Kentucky's abandoned ghost ship has been slowly rusting away, virtually hidden behind trees, driftwood, and massive reeds. Only accessible by hiking across a field and paddling out, this amazing wreck is the Celt, though she's gone by many names over her incredible centurylong story.

Today, observers can paddle up the creek or view her crumbling frame from the river to experience the sheer abandoned awesomeness of Kentucky's ghost ship that had such an extraordinarily storied past.


SHUNKA WARAKIN

The Shunka Warakin, also known as Shunka Warak'in, is a creature referenced in American folklore, purported to resemble a large caniform like a wolf, a feliform such as a hyena, or a hybrid of both. Cryptozoologist Loren Coleman suggests that the Shunka Warakin remains an enigmatic figure absent from contemporary records. Its name, translating to "carries off dogs," hints at its predatory nature. Coleman points to an incident in 1886 involving an animal shot by Israel Ammon Hutchins on what is now the Sun Ranch in Montana, suggesting it could be an instance of this elusive creature. The taxidermist Joseph Sherwood acquired the specimen from Hutchins and displayed it in his store/museum in Henry's Lake, Idaho, dubbing it "Ringdocus." Despite being the sole physical evidence, this stuffed trophy was never subjected to formal scientific examination and was lost for a period before resurfacing in December 2007.

A cryptid is a creature or entity whose existence is suggested by anecdotal evidence, folklore, or alleged sightings, but lacks conclusive scientific evidence for its existence. These entities often exist in the realm of myth, legend, or unverified reports. Examples of cryptids include creatures like Bigfoot, the Loch Ness Monster, the Chupacabra, Mothman, and many others.

Cryptids can be animals, plants, or even beings with supernatural or paranormal attributes. They're subjects of fascination and mystery, often sparking curiosity and investigations by cryptozoologists and enthusiasts seeking to prove or debunk their existence. 

30 Coins



FOR THE SENSES

Oriental False Hawksbeard_Youngia Japonica

I don't know about where you live, but at my house right now, False Hawksbeard is jumping. This stuff is all over the place.


Hawksbeard, in the Asteraceae (daisy) family, is a weedy summer annual herb that can be found growing as an agricultural or environmental weed, and often persisting year-round. Seedlings form a rosette resembling a small sowthistle (Sonchus spp.) but leaves are hairy. Upper leaves are more linear and lack a stalk, and a milky sap is emitted when leaves are torn. In contrast to dandelion, narrowleaf hawksbeard plants have leaves on the flowering stem, and plants can become highly branched. In the rosette stage (i.e., before the flowering stem has bolted upward), it is much trickier to differentiate between narrowleaf hawksbeard and dandelion.

The inflorescence stalk is generally leafless (but occasionally with up to 3 leaves), branched at the top, and 6 to 15 inches (occasionally to 3 feet) tall. Flowers are yellow, and dandelion-like but only about 1/2 inch in diameter. Seed heads are dandelion-like, about 1/4 to 1/2 inches in diameter, and seeds are wind dispersed.

Young leaves and young plant - can be eaten raw or cooked.

The plant is antitussive and febrifuge. It is also used in the treatment of boils and snakebites. Tests have shown it to have compounds that inhibit the growth of certain cancer cells, including chronic myelogenous leukemia and promyelocytic leukemia.

In traditional medicine, Asiatic false hawksbeard has been used as an antidote against poison, as a diuretic, to relieve coughing and to reduce fevers. It is also said to have antibacterial and anti-inflammatory uses.
