

The Mogollon Monster:

Arizona's Hairiest Secret

High in the pine-covered peaks of the Mogollon Rim, where the winds whistle through canyons and campfires flicker nervously in the dark, something ancient stirs. Arizona may be famous for its desert heat and iconic cacti, but its coolest cryptid lives in the shadows of the forest—welcome to the legend of the Mogollon Monster.

Known to some as "Arizona's Bigfoot," this elusive creature has been haunting tales and trails for over a century. Descriptions vary, but most eyewitnesses report a towering, ape-like figure over seven feet tall, covered in shaggy black or reddishbrown hair, and reeking of decay and musk. Locals swear its eyes glow red in the dark, and some say it lets out bloodcurdling screams that echo through the canyons at night.

The earliest documented sightings date back to the early 1900s, when settlers reported seeing the beast while prospecting or hunting.

But Native American stories long predate that, warning of a "hairy man" who roams the woods, guarding sacred ground. Whether spirit or flesh-and-blood creature, the Mogollon Monster commands attention—and respect.

One chilling encounter in the 1940s described the creature tearing through a campsite, scattering gear and howling into the trees. Another, more recent tale from a hiker in 2006, claimed the beast followed him for over a mile, snapping branches and letting out guttural growls, vanishing just before dawn.

Skeptics chalk it up to bears, pranksters, or overactive imaginations in the wilderness. But those who've seen it? They'll tell you it's no bear. It's something else entirely.

So if you ever find yourself camping along the Mogollon Rim—near Payson,
Strawberry, or beyond—keep your eyes peeled and your marshmallows close. The Mogollon Monster doesn't like visitors... especially loud ones.

Spooky Tip: Want to lure the Mogollon Monster? Some say it's drawn to the scent of cooking bacon and the sound

of harmonicas. Just don't be surprised if you get more than you bargained for.

A cryptid is a creature or entity whose existence is suggested by anecdotal evidence, folklore, or alleged sightings, but lacks conclusive scientific evidence for its existence. These entities often exist in the realm of myth, legend, or unverified reports. Examples of cryptids include creatures like Bigfoot, the Loch Ness Monster, the Chupacabra, Mothman, and many others.

Cryptids can be animals, plants, or even beings with supernatural or paranormal attributes. They're subjects



From the ghost towns of Jerome to the shadowy trails of the Superstition Mountains, this is a journey into the unexplained, the uncanny, and the utterly unhinged. Whether you're chasing the Mogollon Monster, hunting cursed gold, or just hoping not to get abducted, one thing's for sure: Arizona is more than just sun and sand—it's a portal to the paranormal.

EXPERIENCE THE HAUNTING HISTORY OF YUMA TERRITORIAL PRISON

For over three decades, the imposing walls of Yuma Territorial Prison contained the American West's most dangerous criminals. More than 3,000 inmates passed through its gates during its years of operation. Though the gallows never claimed a life here, death found 111 prisoners within these walls, and their final resting place remains just beyond the prison grounds—104 souls buried in unmarked graves that bear witness to forgotten lives.

The prison cemetery overlooks the mighty Colorado River, where tragedy echoes across time. On nights when moonlight dances on the water, visitors sometimes glimpse a spectral figure wandering the riverbank—a woman forever searching, forever mourning the daughter she couldn't save from the rushing waters more than a century ago.

LaLarona still haunts the banks...don't go too close else she draws you to an early demise.

Step inside the shadowy corridors where desperation once lived, and listen carefully. Whispered voices drift from the cells, sharing fragments of long-buried stories through motion-activated recordings that bring the past uncomfortably close to the present. The sudden sound of these ghostly narratives will quicken your pulse, even when you know their mechanical origin.

Cell 14 holds particular sorrow. Here, in a moment of final despair, John Ryan—imprisoned for what the records cryptically termed "crimes against nature"—ended his own suffering. Visitors often report an inexplicable chill when passing this cell, as if the Arizona heat cannot penetrate the lingering sadness within.

The most dreaded punishment awaited in the Dark Cell, where the prison's most troublesome inmates faced absolute isolation. Shackled to the cold stone floor for days or weeks, they existed in crushing darkness that seemed to swallow hope itself. Standing in this claustrophobic chamber today, you'll feel the weight of despair that once filled this space, as the rock walls seem to press closer with each passing moment.

In Navajo legend, Skinwalkers are powerful witches who can transform into animals—wolves, coyotes, owls—and move unseen through the desert night. These stories aren't shared lightly, and even speaking of Skinwalkers is taboo in many communities.

Still, reports persist in northern Arizona of glowing-eyed figures, animals walking on two legs, and sudden, unnatural silence blanketing the land. Whether cryptid or cautionary tale, Skinwalkers remain one of the most chilling and culturally rooted pieces of Arizona folklore.

JEROME: THE WICKEDEST TOWN IN THE WEST

- 3 drops geranium
- 3 drops bergamot
- 2 drops spearmint

Diffuse them, dab onto scent stones, or blend with a carrier oil for a roll-on vibe.

BONUS TIP: DRY THOSE HERBS!

If your herb garden is booming (or if you scored big at the farmer's market), don't let anything go to waste. Hang bundles of mint, lavender, or rosemary upside-down in a dry, shady spot for 1–2 weeks. Once crispy, crumble and store in airtight jars. Use them for teas, baths, or potpourri all year long.

Steak Lettuce Wraps with Peanut Sauce

Yields: 4 - 6 serving(s) Prep Time: 20 mins Total Time: 1 hr

Ingredients:

- 5 Tbsp. soy sauce
- 1/4 cup hoisin sauce
- 1 Tbsp. chili-garlic sauce
- 1 Tbsp. grated fresh ginger
- 1 Tbsp. rice vinegar
- 1 tsp. toasted sesame oil
- 1/2 cup chunky peanut butter
- 1 1/2 lb. flank steak
- 1 tsp. vegetable oil
- 2 oz. thin rice noodles
- 2 heads butter lettuce, leaves separated
- 1 1/2 cups matchstick carrots
- 1 English cucumber, sliced into matchsticks
- 1/2 cup fresh mint leaves

Instructions:

Whisk together the soy sauce, hoisin sauce, chili-garlic sauce, ginger, vinegar, and sesame oil in a large bowl. Remove ¼ cup to a medium bowl and whisk in the peanut butter and ¼ cup hot water. Cover and set aside for serving.

Put the steak in a shallow dish and pour the remaining marinade on top, flipping to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 30 minutes and up to 2 hours.

Brush a grill or grill pan with the vegetable oil and heat over medium-high heat. Remove the steak from the marinade and pat dry with paper towels. Grill 4 to 6 minutes per side for medium-rare (a thermometer inserted into the center should read 135°F).

Transfer the steak to a cutting board and let rest 5 minutes. Meanwhile, cook the rice noodles according to the package directions. Slice the steak against the grain. To serve, fill the lettuce leaves with the noodles, steak, carrots, cucumber, and mint and drizzle with some of the peanut sauce. Serve any remaining peanut sauce on the side.

Serving tip:

Serve with a mixed greens salad tossed in lemon vinaigrette and a slice of crusty bread.
